I. POLICY

Every applicant for employment by the department must be examined for emotional stability and physical condition by an individual licensed and qualified to perform the examinations. The examiners shall make a recommendation to the employing agency concerning the applicant's suitability for employment.

- A. After employment, the department reserves the right to have any employee reexamined at anytime to determine his/her fitness for duty.
- B. If a physician or mental health professional indicates the presence of a condition that could limit the officer's physical or emotional ability to cope with the stress of law enforcement duties, he/she will not be eligible for certification as a law enforcement officer with this department.
- C. Specifications S-5 and S-7 of the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training Manual of Rules and Regulations will be used as a guideline for physical and emotional requirements.
