This budget adjustment will carry the PBURA through December 31. She will start with 2025 budget preparation next month.

Commissioner Mouser made a motion to approve the Budget Adjustment as presented. Commissioner Franklin seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Commissioner Griffin reported that the PBURA will receive a check from the State Insurance Department for \$300,000.00. According to the information she has, it is to go back to where the funds came from.
